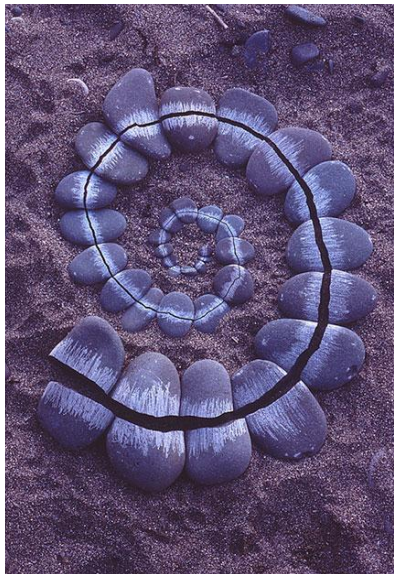


Art From Nature

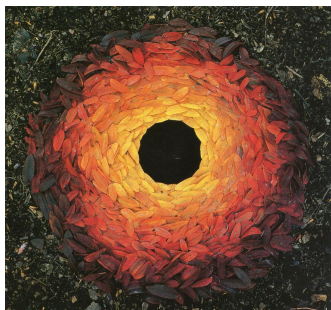
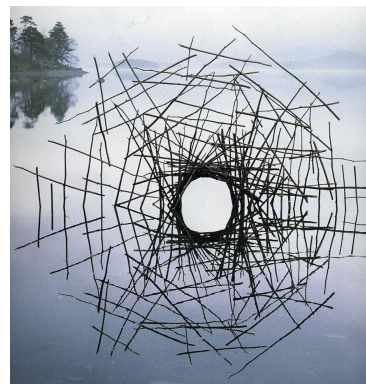
You don't need special art materials to make art!

Artists like **Andy Goldsworthy** use rocks, leaves, flowers, and twigs to make amazing artwork. Here are a few of his pieces. Check him out online if you can.



You might be at home, but you can still create. (#CreateAtHome) See what you can do with the materials you can find in the natural world around you.

Notice how Andy Goldsworthy is really exploring just circles and lines using these materials? He's incredibly patient and sometimes his projects collapse. Don't be surprised if that happens to you. It's normal. You might make a series instead of only one creation. Working on a series is creating multiple versions of an idea. Take photos of your creations if you can.
